Dolphin introduction:

Dolphin (PG) Institute is affiliated to H.N.B Garhwal Central University, Srinagar, It is accredited by NAAC, UGC The Institute is approved by Indian Association of Physiotherapists (IAP), Mumbai and National Council of Teachers Education (NCTE), Jaipur. Also recognized by University Grant Commission (UGC) u/s 2(f).

Journey of Dolphin (PG) Institute began in the year 2002 with a vision to create an educated, ethical and prosperous society by imparting higher education to youth and to enable them to pursue their career in industry and health sector.

The academic session commenced on 01th of August 2016 with the new batch of students from all over the country as well as from our neighbouring countries like Nepal and Bhutan to gain professional and educational excellence.

It brings waves of emotions when I take you down the memory lane a journey , a mission that began with 80 students and 8 faculty members.

Today a total strength of 2,191 students are pursuing in 7 UG and 11 PG courses.

College Strength

Library has facility to access e-resource under National library and information services and recognized as local chapter for NPTEL activities by IIT Madras.

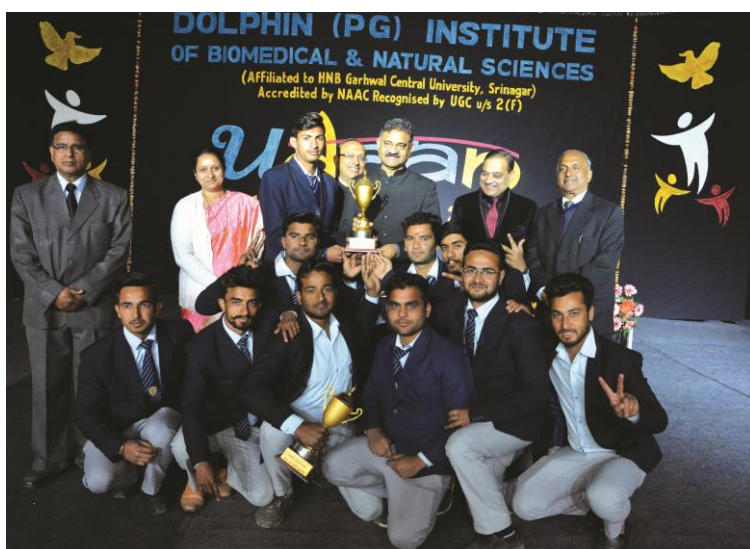
University Results

The performance of Dolphinites in the University Examinations has been consistently well. The annual result of the college is generally much higher than the university average.

In Undergraduate Courses toppers of all streams have scored above 80% with highest in Forestry by Ritwika Mukhopadhyay (86.42%) and in Postgraduate Courses Grade point average is above 8.0 till the last result declared.

Number of students qualified NET/GATE/ SLET were 09 .

Placement

The excellent academic records of our students do not end with the degrees. They get translate into fruitful career in industries, hospitals , teaching and research institutes and other corporate sectors.

Placement cell of the institute has a strong network with the leading industries and research institutes all over India. More than 80% students availed the services from the placement cell.

Research Activities

Institute has duly entered in the field of research activities and has enrolled students for Ph.D programme.

The faculty members also have published books, chapters and research papers in the peer reviewed indexed Journals. Faculty and students participated in various national & International conferences & workshops.

State level –16, National level -27, International level – 04 03 faculties were resource persons in National level conferences.

09 Workshops, Seminars and CME were conducted in the year by different Departments. They were Dept. of Forestry, Biotechnology, Physiotherapy, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Botany, and Biostatistics.

Till date Eleven projects funded by Government agencies and 01 consultancy project funded by Non-Govt. International agency has been carried out by the faculty of the Institute.

Presently 03 projects are ongoing, 01 funded by DBT in the dept. of Microbiology, 01 project funded by Uttarakhand State Biotechnology in dept. of Microbiology, and 01 project funded by Punjab State Science & Technology Council in dept of Botany.

Advanced diagnostic centre equipped with modern facility like Biochemistry analyzer and fully automated cell counter was established.

A new updated Hi- tech computer was also inaugurated

IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell)

The internal quality assurance cell, constituted in the year 2011 based on the recommendations of NAAC it monitors the quality parameters in the Institute.

A NAAC sponsored National seminar was conducted on Quality enhancement through innovative practices in Teaching , Learning and Evaluation.

Beside this International Biodiversity Day, Science Day, Environment Day, Immunology Day, World Heart Day, AIDS Day, Physiotherapy Day, World Diabetes Day, World Wild life Day were celebrated in the Institute.
