

THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is made on the day of 26th May, 2019

WHEREAS

(A) The parties hereto, recognises the benefits of establishing international links, wish to strengthen the ties between their respective institutions by entering into this memorandum of understanding ("MoU").

(B) Ms Kala Bisht (Secretary) Bagwan Grammodhyog Samiti(BGS) Village-Shyampur, PO-Ambiwala Premnagar, Dehradun(UK)-248007 (First Party)

&

Dr. Shailja Pant , Dolphin (PG) Institute of Biomedical & Natural Sciences, Manduwala, Near Suddhowala, Chakrata Road, Dehradun-248007, Uttarakhand, India (Second Party)

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED

PURPOSE

1. The purpose of this MoU is to develop co-operation and promote mutual understanding and excellence in practice-based education, research and knowledge exchange between both the parties.

OBJECTIVES

2. In furtherance of this purpose the parties agree to develop the following activities in collaboration in areas of mutual academic interest for the programs offered at partner institutions:

2.1 Exchange of academic and administrative staff and mutual visits to pursue research and to lecture

2.2 First Party will provide internship, dissertations and research projects to UG and PG Students.

2.3 Identifying opportunities for conducting collaborative /joint research and development.

2.4 Identifying opportunities for conducting lectures and seminars and organising symposia and conference.

2.5 Promoting other academia co-operation and collaboration as mutually agreed.

2.6 First Party will permit access to the students of Second Party in their specialized lab of Spawn Production, Mushroom Production, vermicompost production, apiculture, food processing, nursery raising, medicinal and aromatic plants, socio economic survey for the enhancement of knowledge in above respective field.

VARIATION

3. This MoU may only be amended by a written agreement signed by a duly authorised representative of each party.

CONFIDENTIALITY

4. Each party undertakes not to publish or disclose in any manner whatsoever scientific or technical information belonging to the other party which has been received in the execution of the present contract without prior written consent of the other party. This obligation shall apply as long as such information has not become public property. This commitment shall remain in force during 5 years from the date of signature of this contract, notwithstanding the termination or expiry date of the latter.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

5. Confidential information shared by a party remains in exclusive property. The sharing of such confidential information can in no way be considered or construed as conferring any property rights or patent licence.

DURATION

6. This MoU shall commence of the date of its execution by the last party to sign and shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years. Each party shall review the status of the MoU at least 2 months before the end of the five year period to determine whether it wishes the MoU to continue and, if so, whether any modifications are required. The period of validity of this MoU may only be extended by the mutual written consent of both parties.

TERMINATION

7. Either party may terminate this MoU by giving one months notice in writing to the other. The termination of this MoU shall not affect the implementation of any specific activities established under it prior to such termination.

CHARGES AND LIABILITIES

8. It is understood that the implementation of any types of cooperation stated in clause 2 shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support of the parties concerned.

9. Except as otherwise provided or agreed, the parties shall each bear their own costs and expenses incurred in complying with their obligations under this MoU.

10. Both parties shall remain liable for any losses or liabilities incurred due to their own or their employee's action and neither party intends that the other party shall be liable for any loss it suffers as a result of this MoU.

11. This MoU is not intended to be legally binding, and no legal obligations or legal rights shall arise between the parties from this MoU. The parties enter into the MoU intending to honour all their obligations.

GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

12. Both parties agree that staff and students of either institutions engaged in activities under this MoU shall carry out these activities in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations of their respective university and country after full consultation and approval.
